#### 2024 NYK Scholarship Recipient



Congratulations to **Jennalee Kimiye Leopard** who is this year's Nanka Yamaguchi
Kenjinkai's scholarship recipient. A graduate of Mira Costa High School, Jennalee is very active in many organizations. As evidence of her service, she received the "Committed to Community Award and Youth Award." She has volunteered at JANM.

interned for USC Shoah Foundation and at Johnson Favaro (an architectural firm). She was also a coach for Sender One (a rock climbing gym). Her many other activities, unfortunately, cannot all be listed here.

Academically, Jennalee has been on the Honor Roll every semester since the sixth grade and graduated high school as an AP Scholar with Honors. She is a member of the National Art Honors Society Member, the Tri-M Music Honor Society, and the National Honor Society, and the California Scholarship Federation.

Below are excerpts from one of Jennalee's essays: "My ancestors, Haru and Seijiro, first came to the U.S. in 1905. Their first son Kiyoshi, my great grandfather, was born in 1918. Shortly after that they returned to Iwakuni after the death of Seijiro's father. Their family remained in Iwakuni, but in 1936 Kiyoshi returned to the U.S. at the age of 18, along with his brother and wife. Together, they settled down in a rural neighborhood and started to learn how to speak English. To Kiyoshi, education was the most important thing, and he dedicated himself to earning a high school diploma in the U.S. while also supporting himself and his family by working with his brother as a gardener and landscaper, saving their money until he had enough to lease land to start a flower farm of his own. Even though he faced many challenges, including losing everything and having to start over after World War II, he was still successful in America, and his legacy lives on in our family until this day.

Some interesting facts about my ancestors: Minoru Nange, was one of the last Samurai in Japan. I only know that he was born in 1864, but I do not know anything else about his life or experiences. My great uncle, Keiji Ishii, provided the lumber to restore the Kintaikyo Bridge during its most recent renovation. Also, my great-grandmother was the valedictorian of her lwakuni class and that one of her needlepoint projects is still displayed at her school to this day."

Jennalee will be attending UCLA where she will focus her studies as a Mathematics/Economics major.
